# THE THINNAI PALLIKOODAM

Schooling in the 1930s, which was documented by Ms.Bama Ranganathan appeared in Mylapore Times dated July 28, 2018.



**O**ur Probus member, Probn. S. Ganesan who is a resident of R. K. Nagar in Mandavelipakkam, was interviewed in this regard. He is 85 years old, but his memory is still sharp. And having lived in Mylapore for ages, he has stories to tell. But it is his growing up days in this area that reflect a time and age that is special.

Here is his story - 'I was born on March 23, 1933. My family was a big one, a joint family. And we were not very well off.

'I remember starting school when I was 5 (my dad advanced my year of birth by 1 to get me to school early!). My first school was Raja Rajeshwari School on South Mada Street (it stood in the plot where Sangeetha Hotel now stands).

'It was a *thinnai pallikkoodam*. Do you know what a *thinnai* is?', he asks with a small smile.

'The first year students, all aged 5, would start their classes on the *thinnai* of this house/ school. We would all be seated in a line, and the only objects we carried to school were a slate and a *balpam* (chalk) in a yellow cloth bag'

The students would be taught English, Tamil and arithmetic. Only 3 subjects, after which they could return home. After the first year, they would move indoors to the small rooms which functioned as classrooms for the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> standard classes.

'We had to sit on backless benches, so we couldn't fall asleep or lounge in our seats. The master would also have a *perambu*, which he never hesitated to use: The admission fee to this school was one rupee and monthly fees, one rupee.

'Those were the times. You could get 1 *veesai* (1.5 litre) of gingelly oil or vegetables for ₹ 2 and a dozen hill bananas for 20 paise. You could get chillies for one *dambdi* (1/192 of a rupee). ₹ 100 per month was considered a very good pay'.

'In 1947-48, my family built a house off St. Mary's Road. The entire cost of the house, including construction was ₹ 9000'.

After completing his primary schooling at the Mada Street school, Ganesan moved to P. S. High School, Mylapore for his higher secondary education.

He has vivid memories of some of his teachers. 'I was taught mathematics by M. K. Rajagopala Sastry. He was a brilliant teacher and cultivated a love for the subject. There was also U. V. Ramachandran, my English teacher. He really brought Shakespeare to life'

Ganesan also recalls a classmate who was his inspiration.

'My family was not well off. On St. Mary's Road, there was a cobbler who used to sew chappals from tyres. This is what my dad would buy for us, ten paise a pair. I would wear this to school. Only when I went to college, did I buy a pair of shoes'.

'One of my school mates was the son of the general manager at Simpson & Co. He would arrive in a car, with neatly pressed clothes and shiny shoes. I was determined that one day I would also ride in a car.' Carnatic music was very popular, and film music was widely listened to'.

'R.R. Sabha was the leading one in Mylapore in my time. People loved attending *kutcheris* here and also at Sri Kapali Temple. People would even sit on the steps of the temple tank to listen to the music concerts organised at the temple after *utsavams*'.

'Kapali Talkies, where Kapali Towers now stands, was a film theater. For 2 annas you could get a floor ticket and 15 annas was the highest ticket price' 'Indian Bank, on North Mada Street was the only bank. I remember my father asking me to withdraw ₹ 50 from the bank, all in one rupee notes'. After his SSLC, Ganesan joined the Government Arts College to pursue a B.Sc. in mathematics.

A job with Hindustan Steel followed, after which Ganesan steadily climbed the corporate ladder to retire as a chief executive of a company in Chennai.

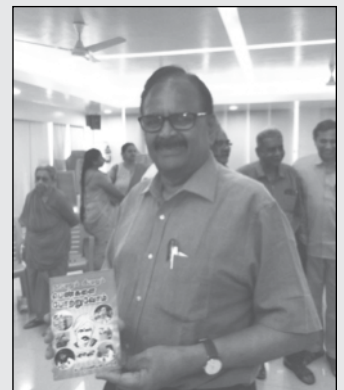
