SECRETARY'S REPORT



Dear Probians,

My Kind Greetings to all of you, your family members and friends.

I am delighted to write this issue on the occasion of

The Madras Day celebration.

In Tamil Nadu, Chennaiites and others celebrate the founding of the city of Madras (now Chennai). Madraspatnam or Chennapatnam is widely acknowledged to have been purchased by the East India Company on 22 August 1639, the date which is celebrated every year. In 2004, Chennai-based journalist Vincent D'Souza first proposed a Madras Day to historian Late S. Muthiah along with several members of the Chennai Heritage Foundation. Madras Day celebrations take place every year without fail since then and several events are held including exhibitions, lectures, film screenings, and quizzes.

It is good to know that Corona infections have dropped drastically in Chennai and Tamilnadu. Nevertheless, we shouldn't be complacent. We should pursue for the next few years the SMS concept, no matter what. A safety mask, distancing during social interactions, and sanitisation are essential for survival. It's more important to survive the next couple of years than to worry about your income.

Our EC meeting for August took place on 14th August 2021. Twenty-four Probians, including office bearers, executive committee members, and special Invitees attended. EC member Pn Geetha Viswanathan rendered the Universal prayer. President Pn B. Ranganathan welcomed the participants in the meeting. He appealed to members to donate liberally for insertion in our Annual Book which will be held on October 1st week 2021. Treasurer PF V. Balachander read his Treasurer's Report. Editor Pn A. Vijayakumar spoke about Probuzz Newsletter Status and Website status. The Secretary gave the vote of thanks.

The August 2021 Monthly meeting started with Universal Prayer rendered by Pn Jayashree Kishore in a melodious voice on 28th Aug 2021.

The Guest Speaker was Mr Karthik Bhat, a Chartered Accountant. Outside of his profession,

Karthik has been involved in freelance research and writing on Madras and its heritage since 2008. He has contributed articles on the subject to Madras Musings, a fortnightly dedicated to the city. Karthik is also an amateur Tamil theatre artist. A co-founder of Chennai Drama House, started in 2008 by a group of alumni from Vidya Mandir, he has more than 275 stage appearances to his credit with various city-based drama troupes. Our President Pn B. Ranganathan welcomed the Guest Speaker Mr Karthik Bhat and the Gathering in Zoom meeting. He appealed to Probians to contribute to the Annual Book advertisement. Our Jt. Secretary PF G. Sadagopan Introduced our Guest Speaker. Mr Karthik Bhat spoke on the **Topic "Interesting Facts about Madras now called Chennai". Sri Karthik Bhat** explained the Madras City very nicely. He explained the details with his PowerPoint Presentation. He started calling "Madras as the 1st City of Modern India. Seeking a permanent trading settlement and investment in a textile-producing area, the East India Company negotiated in July 1639 the purchase of a strip of 'no man's sand' three miles long, one mile wide, protected by the surf-wracked waters of the Bay of Bengal. On 22nd August 1639, Mr Beri Thimmappa and the Dubash of Mr Francis Day concluded a deal to establish the Fort St. George. In those days, Translators were called Dubash. They were assisting the Madras people with French, Dutch, Portuguese and English people. The Dubashes had become Rich and Powerful, they even controlled the Army. Many prominent streets of Madras are named after the Dubashes i.e., Linghi Chetty Street, Thambu Chetty Street, Kasi Chetty Street. Shri Karthik also showed the Madras map of 1710. The Present High court of Madras was situated at "The Great Pagodas" on those days. He said that Chennai corporation was the 2nd oldest corporation in the world after London and the first mayor of Chennai was Nathaniel Higginson on 29th Sep 1688. Britishers contributed to Chenna Keshava and Chenna Malleeswarar Temple for construction and maintenance. He also mentioned that the Yale University of USA was named after Mr Elihu Yale, the then Governor of Fort St. George (in the Period 1687 to 1692). The place of English burial ground in those days was today's Law College. Organised cricket in India started from Madras and Island Ground was used for Cricket Play. There are Two Clubs - one

was MCC for whites and the other one was MUC for others. Responsible for founding the Club was M. Buchi Babu Naidu of the Dera Venkataswami Naidu clan, and a few of his friends who shared his passion for the game. Regarding Madras Movies, a woman, who went by the name of Mrs Klug, was the first to establish a 'permanent' cinema theatre in Madras during April 1911. Probian Dr V Chockalingam MD also shared his experience on Madras. Everyone enjoyed the way Mr Karthik Bhat delivered his speech. His interaction with our members in the question-and-answer session was also well received by our Probians. The vote of thanks was proposed by Pn M. Annadhurai, Secretary.

HILARIOUS "MURPHY'S LAWS"
