Mr. Solomon Devadoss, Principal, Brotherhood Matriculation HSS, Neelankarai, Chennai was the Chief Guest. He spoke well and advised the students to concentrate on studies and physical activity like sports. PPP Venkatachari administered the Oath against Elders Abuse to the students. The **Probus Award of Excellence-2019** was presented to **(1) Master Ranveer Sharma**, a student of DAV Boys HSS, Gopalapuram, who represented his school at

Abhiramani**, X Std., Ganapathy Iyer GHS, Gopalapuram was given the Cash Award for **"Best Student for Social Work,"** instituted by Pn. Dr. S. Krishnamoorthy in memory of late Pn V. Balasubramanian. In addition, Late PF C.R. Vaitheeswaran and V. Chandra **Cash Awards** were given to **Selvi P. Jayashree, CGHSS, Saidapet; Selvi S. Fathima Rinaya, CGHSS, Market St., Perambur, and Selvan G. Hemanth, CHS, Erukkancherry** who were **Corporation School Toppers in 10th Board Exams** held in March 2019; **Cash Awards** were also given to **Selvi V. Nirosha of CGHSS, Nungambakkam and Selvan A. Nirmal of CBHSS, Nungambakkam** (who could not come) both of Chennai GHSS, Nungambakkam for securing **highest mark in Tamil** in the school.

Memorandum Of Representations Presented To Hon'ble Thiru Ma Foi K. Pandia Rajan, Minister For Tamil Official Language & Tamil Culture, Chief Guest, At The Elders' Day Function Conducted By The Federation Of Senior Citizens' Associations Of Tamilnadu On Sunday The 10 November 2019 At The Anna Adarsh College For Women, Shanthi, Anna Nagar, Chennai – 600 040. This meeting appreciates the excellent facilities that the Government of Tamil Nadu has been providing for the benefit of senior citizens in the fields of social security, medicine, transport, housing etc., but feels that millions of senior citizens belonging to the weaker sections are still outside the scope of the relevant schemes. There is therefore considerable need for the government to launch more and more welfare measures and ensure that the intended benefits reach all the eligible. Some suggestions for fulfilling this need given below may please be considered in this connection. Immediate steps should be taken to announce the State's Policy on Older Persons, which has remained in cold storage for long. A Directorate wholly dedicated to the subject of welfare of senior citizens should be formed and it should be the duty of this body to conduct periodical survey of the status of the elders (seniors as well as super seniors) in the urban and rural areas and come out with proposals for measures that would enable them to lead a life of comfort and dignity. The Government should conceive and bring forth a social security net that places in the hands of every senior citizen a pension which is adequate to lead a life of reasonable comfort.

The medical facilities for senior citizens in the State should not only be the best but also affordable. The hospitals, doctors and equipment should be upgraded with this end in view. Geriatric wards, geriatric doctors and paramedical staff trained in geriatric care should be available in every government hospital at least at the district level. Health Insurance should be affordable and all private hospitals should be obligated to join the insurance schemes and offer their services at standardized rates. Travel in public transport systems for senior citizens should be easy and comfortable and possible at free or concessional rates. Special travel facilities should be provided for all senior citizens to undertake sightseeing tours to places of historic importance and or go on pilgrimage to religious centers. "Meals on Wheels" service is a facility desired by many a senior citizen. This should be made available directly by the government or through grant-aided NGOs. If necessary, the NGOs may be granted a capital grant also for starting the service. As mandated in the Senior Citizens Welfare Act, old age homes (of standardized size and specifications) should be opened early in every district. Homeless and abandoned elderly found often on the streets should be picked up and housed in these homes. Senior citizens are often the soft targets of criminals and unsocial elements. The Police have been instructed to keep a watch over such vulnerable persons and offer their protection. For more reasons than one, these instructions are not always followed. Deploying police personnel exclusively for this purpose would be helpful. Supplying assistive devices such as walkers, spectacles, hearing aids, artificial limbs, motorized vehicles etc, either freely or at a concessional price would be of great help in enriching the life of handicapped seniors belonging to the poorer sections.

MINISTER PROMISES TO LOOK INTO POLICY FOR THE ELDERLY

Federation seeks accessible medical facilities in hospitals

Minister for Tamil Culture Ma Foi K. Pandiarajan on Sunday said the State government had always been receptive to the needs of senior citizens, and would take steps towards announcing the State policy for elderly persons.

Speaking at the Elders' Day celebrations organised by the Federation of Senior Citizens' Associations of Tamil Nadu (FOSCATAN), Mr. Pandiarajan referred to the federation's suggestions for a policy for elders, and said the government would examine it. "The government has recently also begun the disbursement of old-age pension for nearly five lakh new beneficiaries, and we hope to reach out to more senior citizens across the State," he said. Mr. Pandiarajan encouraged federation members to come together and support each other.

"Looking to each other for support and ensuring there is regular interaction and positive discussions are essential," he added.

D. Rajasekaran, president, FOSCATAN, said the association acknowledged the various schemes and initiatives by the Tamil Nadu government for the benefit of senior citizens.

"We, however, want these to be made more accessible to many senior citizens, who are from the weaker sections of the society.

The federation has appealed for accessible medical facilities, including geriatric wards, doctors and paramedical staff trained in the field available in every government hospital at the district level," he said. The association has also asked that every senior citizen be given a pension adequate to lead a life of reasonable comfort.

Among the other suggestions, they wanted public transport to be made more comfortable and reasonable for senior citizens.

They also sought arrangements for sightseeing tours to places of historic importance.
