EDITOR'S
COLUMN

The Executive Committee (EC) Meeting of our Club was conducted virtually using the Zoom app. on Monday, the 31st August, 2020. The EC approved that the term of the Office Bearers and EC Members ended in June, 2020 on completion of two years; and, hence the present group of Office Bearers and EC Members would continue to act as Caretaker team and continue to discharge their duties in their respective positions till situations normalise and the AGM and Elections are held; this would be submitted to the AGM for ratification and post-facto approval, at the earliest possible time. The EC also approved the Audited Financial Statements of the Club for final approval by the AGM.

The EC also sanctioned ₹10,000/- each as Medical Relief under the Silver Jubilee Senior Citizen Medical Benefit Fund (SJSCMBF) to two persons, viz., Sri K. Kondala Rao and Sri M. Balachandran who had been given Medical Assistance for partial paralysis and diabetic foot surgery respectively last financial year also as these were the only two applications received so far with a condition that they should not expect such assistance every year from our club.

The EC approved a donation of ₹10,000/- to the Project Orange of the Rotary Club of Velachery for cataract operations of the Senior Citizens. We are extremely thankful to Sri A. Mohan auditor who himself gave an amount of ₹5,000/-, IPP R.T. Namasivayam who gave ₹4,000/- and Pn Prabhakar, EC Member who gave ₹1,000/-.

Our Club collected ₹1,33,084/- as Corona Relief Fund till 31st August, '20. Our Corona relief activities included donations to (i) Cancer Institute – ₹25,000/-; (ii) Sevalya – ₹10,000/-; (iii) Thakkar Bapa Vidyalya Samithi – ₹10,000/-; (iv) Akshaya Patra Foundation – ₹10,000/-; (v) Bhoomika Trust – ₹10,000/-; (vi) providing Thermal Scanner and Oxymeter to the Charu Old Age Home - ₹3,110/-; (vii) Providing relief by donation of Provisions to the Velachery slum dwellers (twice): ₹29,549/-; (viii) Providing Provisions to the temporary employees of the Russian Centre of Science & Culture; & (ix) Provisions to the girls staying in the Sarvodaya Girls Hostel, run by Harijan Seva Sangh started by Gandhiji – ₹14,750/-. The President, Secretary, Treasurer and Joint Treasurer

physically participated in extending the relief works at various places and the photos were shared in the Probus WhatsApp groups. In addition, the EC sanctioned relief of ₹6,500/- each to (i) Old Age Home, Satyanarayana Charitable Trust, Nanmangalam (Managed by Sri Sekar, Probus Excellence Awardee) & (ii) Blind Girls Hostel run by Rajeswari Charitable Trust, Nanganallur (Managed by Sri Radhakrishnan, Probus Excellence Awardee). In addition, individual Probians have contributed to various organisations for covid19 relief work.

Probians being above 60 years of age, are the most vulnerable Senior Citizens group for Corona Virus and depression due to loneliness. As such, we have to take precautions by boosting our immunity and keeping our physical health and mental cheerfulness and hope in the mean time. Kindly Join the “Probus WhatsApp” group if you have not done so to ensure that you spend your time exchanging ideas and news in the WhatsApp group. Also download ZOOM app in your smartphone and participate in the Monthly Meeting. **I request all of you to join September month's Monthly Meeting using ZOOM App in PC or Mobile, to be held on FRIDAY, the 25th September, '20 where the Pn Dr. V. Chockalingam would be talking on “HEALTH IS WEALTH IN COVID19.”**
