FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Dear Probians,



Loving Greetings to you
and your family members.

With a heavy heart I had
to share with you that our
IPP PF S. Gopalakrishnan,
aged 91 years, attained the
Lotus Feet of the God on
28th Feb., '23 and his last
rights were performed on
the 1st March, 2023. He was
the first to be the President

of the Club for a continuous period of three years. He was humble, amiable and friend to all. He retired as DGM from Central Bank of India and after retirement became advisor to Nidhi Companies, wrote financial articles in DINAMANI, KALAIMAGAL and other magazines, Newspapers, extensively participated in the TV interviews and Budget and Financial Discussions. His writing was simple, short, and lucid. He steered the Probus Club of Chennai in good stead and was well known to famous persons like Nalli, Kalaimamani Kizhambur Sankarasubramanian, Editor of KALAIMAGA. This year he was one of the judges of our Club's Short Story competition held through KALAIMAGA. He was slightly depressed after his wife's demise, fell down and had a hairline crack

in his thigh bone on 10th December, '22 just a day before he was to be honoured as Immediate Past President as a part of our Three Decades of the Club Celebrations. He was always thinking and talking about our Club during our Weekly visits. Though he came home from ICU in Geri Hospital, he lost a lot of muscle and never recovered. He had earlier in his tenure, released a book written by Pn. Brig. George Mathew titled Reveries of Love and Life and what a coincidence, Pn Brig. George Mathew and our IPP had their funeral on the same day. Brigadier was a gentleman to the core and used to be my bridge partner along with Pn John N.G. and Pn M. Prabhakar and we used to play bridge weekly twice. He suffered from Prostate cancer and lack of platelets generation from bone marrow. He attained the Lotus feet of the Lord on 26th Feb., '23. Pn Pushpa B Shah came for our last month's Monthly meeting and had a heart attack and breathed her last on 12th Feb., '23. She was Vice-President of our Club and had contributed to the Club's growth by collecting Advertisements and also actively donating for Children's Day Function, etc. She even danced with her daughter-in-law against her husband's wishes a few years ago. Always neatly dressed in white saree in Gujarathi style and carried herself silently in a dignified manner. Demise of our ex-EC Member, Pn Parthasarathy K on 20th Feb. was also sad as he was suffering from a lung failure

and difficulty in breathing. He was also the General Secretary of the SBI Officers' Association as well as the FOSCATON to which our Club is affiliated. We all paid respects to their mortal remains and also paid homage in the EC Meeting and our Club Meetings.

In the EC Meeting held on 11th Feb., '23, it was decided that **the International Women's Day** combined with the Monthly Breakfast meeting will be held in **the auditorium of the Russian House on Friday, the 24th March, '23 as a joint function** with the Russian House as a Photo Exhibition would be opened in the Exhibition Hall after our Club's function. Madras - Chennai City Names of Important Places - Interesting Details Received by Email from Pn. Jayakumar Sambandam

Alwarpet is named after Thirumangai Aalvaar.

Chrompet was either named after the Chromium that was discharged from the Leather Tanneries in the area or the Chrome Leather Factory established In 1912. The pollution destroyed Nagalkeni Lake.

Egmore was originally Elumboor which means the seventh village bought by the British.

Kodambakkam is the mispronunciation of Ghoda Bagh where the stables of the Nawab of Arcot were once located.

Mambalam means ripe mango fruit (mamb palam)

Mangadu is named after the mango (mangaa) trees

Madras has more than one origin. According to one theory, it was named after the village of Madrasa Pattinam where Fort St George was situated. According to another, it was named after the Madra family, to which the girl friend of Francis Day - the man who bought the land for the British - belonged.

Mount Road was named after St.Thomas Mount, which was originally connected to Fort St George by a dirt track called Mount Road

Mylapore was named after the peacocks and peahens (mayil in Tamil) that once roamed here. Parvathi also incarnated herself as a peahen to worship Shiva.

Pallavaram was originally Pallavapuram and is the oldest known settlement in Chennai going back to the paleolithic period.

Parry's Corner was named after Thomas Parry, a trader who landed in 1788.

Perambur means the place with a lot of affection. Per + Anbu means lots of affection.

Pondy Bazaar is named after W.P.A. Soundara Pandian of the self-respect movement.

Pulicat comes from Palaverkaadu, which means the forest of mangroves.

Purasawalkam was originally Purasaipakkam after the Purasu or flame of forest tree.

Saidapet is named after one Syed Khan, to whom the Nawab of Arcot gifted the land in 1730

Tenampet is named after the coconut groves (thennampattai) that once flourished here.

Thirusulam is derived from suram (jungle path) and was the headquarters of SurathurNaadu in the past

Thiruverkaadu is named after the vela or acacia tree.

Thousand Lights commemorates the assembly hall that once stood there and was lit by a thousand lamps during the Muslim observance of Muhurram

Triplicane was originally Thiru-- Alli-- Keni named after the tank of the white lily.

Vandalur is a shortened version of the ancient Vandai Nagaram.

Otteri is the tank near Vepery, or Otha Yeri (single reservoir)

Vepery is named after the neem (Vembu in Tamil) trees on the banks of the yeri (water reservoir) Vembu Yeri

Washermanpet was the place where unprocessed cloth from the looms was washed and bleached.
