MANILA CITY (PHILIPPINES) - WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM

Pbn. A.G. Pranesan, Dy Chief Engineer(Retd), Tamilnadu Water Supply & Drainage Board.

Preamble

It was a pleasant surprise for me, when I was chosen as one of the Team Member to go to Manila in September 2006 for carrying out "Due Diligence" to establish assets and liabilities and evaluate commercial potential for taking over Manila Water Supply & Sewerage System and for preparing Bid Documents for submission. About 50 officials comprising of Engineers, Accountants & Audit officials and Managerial persons from IL&FS were in the group.

Background on Manila Water Supply Project

Source of water for Manila city is from 3 dams. Raw water is conveyed to two existing Treatment Plants - one with a capacity of 2,400 Million Litres/ Day (MLD) & another of 1,600 MLD capacity. They are huge in comparison to the biggest Water Treatment plant of 530mld capacity at Chembarambakkam providing water to Chennai city. Look at the magnitude & size of these Treatment Plants at Manila - looking like an ocean. The entire system was being managed by a private operator, whose lease period was ending and Manila Water had to select a new operator. IL&FS was one of the four firms shortlisted to quote.

Scope of Our Work

Our task was to visit the source, alignment of pumping main, pumping stations, treatment plant, etc. and asses their condition and prepare the bid document for operating and maintaining the system for the next 25 years. The bid conditions included purchase of shares which would largely determine the successful bidder.

Prevailing Condition at Manila City

Generally unsafe for foreigner and we were advised not to go alone anywhere. When inspecting existing water supply system at slums, we were asked to leave all valuables including cell phone, passport etc. in the car. Heavy traffic during the morning and evening office hours made us travel long hours to reach our temporary office and to return to the hotel. We used to leave the hotel early and return late at night to avoid traffic. It was hard time for vegetarians at

the hotel. Roads are well concreted.

Condition of Water Distribution System


During the inspection, we could visualise the most difficult part of the project would be to detect leaks and rectify them as the loss of water was about 60% against permissible limit of 30%. Most of the roads are concreted & pipes in many areas are at 2 to 3 m deep below ground level making it difficult to locate leaks even with modern equipment. All house service connections are metered. In poor community areas, to prevent theft of water, the pipes are laid above ground level.

Water for the Poor Communities

Manila water took a major & implementable decision to form "Local Government Units" and "Community based Organisations" and guided to fix bulk water meters and communal meters. Manila water made these two units responsible for day-to-day management and operation of all the facilities including repair, maintenance, and monitoring of pipes etc. They are also responsible for monthly billing, collection, and remittance of the revenue from the individual household's water consumption charges. Initial capital investment required are sourced by Manila Water Authority. During the operation, revenue collected from monthly water bills are used for operation and maintenance expenses. Finally, it fostered strong community relationship, empowered community members, and made the poor community feel that they are legitimate part of the society.

Conclusion

IL&FS Team collected all field data in 2 weeks, arrived at cost factor based on our team's inputs and prepared Bid Documents but was unsuccessful in bid process.




